## Commentary: These proposed changes:

- Alter the club's committee by (i) increasing the number of Junior Organiser posts from one to two; (ii) adding Race Promotions Co-ordinator as a committee post; (iii) removing Kit Manager as a committee post; (iv) reducing the number of committee posts without portfolio from two to one, with a clause to encourage members who have not previously served on the committee to take up this post.
- 2) Make the Auditor an AGM appointment, and not require the Auditor to be a member. At present the Auditor is a committee appointment; this change is to ensure, as far as possible, the independence of the Auditor.
- 3) Clarify that the President, Officers, Committee and all persons appointed to roles by the committee must be members.
- 4) Allow Second Claim Under 18 members. Some Under 18s who are members of other clubs train with us, so this will allow them to join if they wish to do so.
