#### **Treasurer's Report**

I am pleased to report that the club's financial position remains sound and has operated at a small surplus for the year 2013-2014 of £324.

The accounts now more fully reflect the activities of the club by including the financials from the several races the club promotes.

Subscription income has fallen slightly due to lapsed memberships, but overall membership numbers remain healthy at 437. There is a small corresponding decrease in the amount we have paid to England Athletics by way of affiliation fees. Expenditure on the newsletter has also reduced as more members opt to use the electronic version.

During the financial year we hosted the FRA dinner as well as our own annual presentation evening and this is reflected in the accounts.

The club has also benefitted from a successful bid to obtain a Lottery Award from Sport England of £8904.

Our juniors have been a worthy cause for donations once again and through our promoted races the club also makes donations to other causes including a £1000 donation from the Pendle Fell Races split equally between the Rossendale and Pendle Mountain Rescue and Derian House.

In the forthcoming financial year it is anticipated that the club will operate at a small deficit due to expected increases in the England Athletics affiliation fees. However there is no proposal to the AGM to amend the current rate of subscription.
